

## Revelation of Jesus

This is a special message to seven historical churches with a timeless application to churches from all periods of history, and personal application to Christians in our modern world--it is relevant to every era. And, it comes with it's own special blessing to those who read it.

## Be Blessed

**Objectives:** Fun competition between family members  
Gain knowledge about the future tribulation period.  
Have fun with your family.

**Number of Players:** 3 or more

**Length:** 30 minutes - 1 hour

**Set up:** Set up an area around your dining table or living room where everyone can face each other. Give everyone a pair of spoons that they can bang together to signal when they want to answer the question. Also, give everyone a Bible in case they need to look up the answers. Designate one person as the show host. They will be the score keeper, timer keeper and the host who asks the questions. Have paper and pencils/pens/markers/crayons/etc ready for a drawing question.

**Rules:** The Host will begin by explaining the rules. A question will be asked and anyone can answer the question. To indicate they want to answer the question they should bang their spoons together. Then they have 10 seconds to answer the question. If they answer correctly, they receive 5 points. If they don't answer correctly or they don't answer within the 10 seconds, the host will buzz them and then any of the other contestants may indicate they want to answer by banging their spoons together. If no one answers, the host will tell the answer and move on to the next question. You can use your bibles to look up answers--however, you should do this before you bang your spoons as once you do that, you only have 10 seconds to answer. There will also be some drawing questions where you are instructed to draw. Make sure each person has paper and pencils/pens/markers/crayons/etc for those types of questions. After all of the questions are asked, total the points of each player to determine who the winner is.

1	How did the book of Revelation get its name?	Rev 1:1 "The Revelation of Jesus Christ..." It names itself
2	Where did the Revelation come from?	Rev 1:1 "...which God gave Him to show His servants..."
3	On what day was John in the Spirit?	Rev 1:10 "I was in the Spirit on the Lord's Day..."
4	Host: Read aloud Rev 1:10-18. Then give the contestants 10 seconds to write down 4 descriptions of Jesus given in the text. (everyone who gets 4 right answers will receive the 5 points)	use your Bible to see if they give the right answer
5	What are the seven Lampstands?	Rev 1:20 "...seven lampstands which you saw are the seven churches."
6	Finish this sentence: "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will _____."	Rev 3:20 "...I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me."
7	What is the person with an ear directed to do?	Rev 3:22 "...let him hear what the spirit says to the churches."
8	Revelation chapter 4: describe the voice that John heard and what did it say?	Rev 4:1 "...the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying, 'Come up here, and I will show you things which must take place after this.'"
9	What was around the throne?	Rev 4:3-4 "...and there was a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald....around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones...twenty-four elders sitting..."

10	What were the 24 elders clothed in and what was on their heads?	Rev 4:4 "...I saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed in white robes; and they had crowns of gold on their heads."
11	What proceeded from the throne?	Rev 4:5 "And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices."
13	What was before the throne?	Rev 4:5-6 "Seven lamps of fire were burning before the throne...In front of the throne was something like a sea of glass as clear as crystal."

	Question	Answer
13	<p>You have 3 minutes to draw the four living creatures in the center of the throne and on each side of the throne. I will describe them and say “Go” and you will draw what you can remember from my reading. I will say stop when your time is done. “Revelation 4:6-11 In the center of the throne and on each side of the throne were 4 living creatures full of eyes in front and in back The first living creature was like a lion, the second living creature like a calf, the third living creature had a face like a man, and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle. The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">“Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!”</p> <p>Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever, the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">“You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created.”</p>	<p>Everyone gets 5 points for their drawing.</p>
14	<p>What was in the had of Him who sat on the throne?</p>	<p>Rev 5:1 “...a scroll written inside and on the back, sealed with seven seals.”</p>
15	<p>Why did John “weep much?”</p>	<p>Rev 5:4 “...because no one was found worthy to open and read the scroll, or to look at it.”</p>

	Question	Answer
16	Who was worthy to open the scroll?	Rev 5:5 "...Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals."  Rev 6:1 "...the Lamb..."
17	What did John see when the first seal was opened?	Rev 6:2 "...a white horse. He who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer."
18	What did John see when the second seal was opened?	Rev 6:4 "...another horse, fiery red, went out. And it was granted to the one who sat on it to take peace from the earth, and that people should kill one another; and there was given to him a great sword."
19	What was the purpose of the white horse?	Rev 6:2 "...he went out conquering and to conquer."
20	What was the purpose of the red horse?	Rev 6:4 "...take peace from the earth..."
21	What did John see when the third seal was opened?	Rev 6:5 "...a black horse, and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand..."
22	What was the purpose of the black horse?	Rev 6:5-6 "...He who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand. And I heard a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying, 'a quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not harm the oil and the wine.'"
23	What did John see when the fourth seal was opened?	Rev 6:8 "...behold, a pale horse."

	Question	Answer
24	What was the purpose of the pale horse?	Rev 6:8 "...the name of him who sat on it was Death, and Hades followed with him. And power was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword, with hunger, with death, and by the beasts of the earth."
25	When John saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth, what were they doing?	Rev 7:1 "...holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, on the sea, or on any tree."
26	When John saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of God...what did the angel say with a loud voice?	Rev 7:3 "Do not harm the earth, the sea, or the trees will we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads."
27	How long will the two witnesses prophesy?	Rev 11:3 "...one thousand two hundred and sixty days..." 42 months or 3.5 years
28	What are the two witnesses wearing?	Rev 11:3 "...clothed in sackcloth."
29	What special protection do the two witnesses have from anyone who wants to harm them?	Rev 11:5 "And if anyone wants to harm them, fire proceeds from their mouth and devours their enemies. And if anyone wants to harm them, he must be killed in this manner."
30	What special power do the two witnesses have?	Rev 11:6 "These have power to shut heaven, so that no rain falls in the days of their prophecy; and they have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to strike the earth with all plagues as often as they desire."
